1. F.O.B POINT AND FREIGHT CHARGES (Clause D-10.1) (June 2007)

The items purchased under this purchase order/contract will be F.O.B. Destination. Freight charges shall be borne by Seller.

Commented [RCC1]: Include in solicitations and purchase orders/contracts (including delivery orders against Government contracts) that involve shipment of items. The "F.O.B." (free on board) point is the location at which ownership is established and from which shipping/delivery charges generally begin to accrue. The purpose of this clause is to define that point and who (Buyer or Seller) pays the freight bill from that point forward.
