

## 1. BAR CODE LABELING (Clause D-11.2) (November 2002)

Seller shall affix the Buyer furnished bar code label(s) as specified below.

### Serial Numbered Parts

Parts shall be individually packaged and the applicable bar code label affixed to the package/shipping container.

In order for Buyer to provide labels in a timely manner, the Seller shall telephone, fax, or e-mail the Buyer the following information:

- Design Agency Part Number and Nomenclature
- Date Code
- Serial Number(s)

### Non-Serialized Parts

When the shipment consists of solely non-serialized parts of the same kind, multiples of these parts may be included in the shipping container. Individual packaging is not required for purposes of bar code labeling.

In order for the Buyer to provide labels in a timely manner, the Seller shall telephone, fax, or e-mail the Buyer the following information:

- Design Agency Part Number and Nomenclature
- Total quantity of parts per shipping container

For serialized and non-serialized parts, place the bar code label in the upper left corner on the side of the shipping container. The regular shipping label shall be affixed to the upper right corner on the side of the shipping container. Placement of the labels is important so that the labels may be visible when the shipping containers are stacked or palletized.
