1. DESTRUCTIVE TEST UNITS - HELD BY SELLER (Clause E-3.1) (April 1999)

Destructive Tests (D-Tests) are a part of the specifications for this unit. Each time a shipment is made, and before invoice for shipment can be paid, Seller shall mail to the attention of Buyer's Purchasing Department Representative two copies of the necessary D-Test papers or other test data as described in the applicable specifications; or, if so directed by the Buyer, certification that D-Test units met specification requirements. All test data must be furnished on Buyer's form 1424, Technical Data Envelope, supplied by the Buyer.

D-Test units shall be marked as required by the applicable specifications, or if not specified, with a "D" in two places, in contrasting colors, as large as possible. D-Test units will be segregated and held by Seller until notified that this purchase order/contract is complete and disposition instructions have been received from the Buyer. In the event Seller is to scrap the D-Test units, Seller must certify on Buyer's form 464, Scrap Warranty, that D-Test units have been altered in such a manner as to make them non-functional for any purpose other than reclamation of basic material content.
