

1. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY (Clause F-4.1) (August 2004)

The following personnel are hereby authorized to act as delegated Buyer representative(s) for the specific purpose(s) shown, subject to the limitations shown. The Buyer representative(s) shall have no supervisory authority over the Seller's personnel.

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Duties Delegated:

- Secure and furnish such interpretations of technical requirements as the Buyer and Seller may require.
- Provide technical liaison as required.
- Observe performance and acceptance tests as may be required.

The delegated Buyer representative(s) do not have the authority for the following:

- Approval of invoices
- Additional work outside the scope of the purchase order
- A change as defined by the "Changes" article of the terms and conditions
- Changes to any of the other expressed terms and conditions
- Changes to the delivery schedule(s)

Note: The Buyer's Purchasing Representative is the only person who can legally obligate the Buyer for the expenditure of funds, changes in the scope of work or level of effort, changes to the terms and conditions and the negotiating and signing of legally binding documents. Commitments, obligations, promises (either implied or expressed) by the delegated Buyer representative(s) do not bind the Buyer in any manner or fashion.
