

1. LIMITATIONS ON PASS-THROUGH CHARGES -- IDENTIFICATION OF SUBCONTRACT EFFORT (Clause B-1.2) (June 2025)

In accordance with FAR Clause 52.215-22 "Limitations on Pass-Through Charges -- Identification of Subcontract Effort", the Seller shall identify in its proposal the total cost of the work to be performed by the Seller, and the total cost of the work to be performed by each subcontractor, under the Order, task order, or delivery order.

☐ Check this box if the Seller intends to subcontract more than seventy (70) percent of the total cost of work to be performed under the Order, task order, or delivery order, and provide the following information in the proposal:

1. The amount of the Seller's indirect cost and profit/fee applicable to the work to be performed by the subcontractor(s); and
2. A description of the added value provided by the Seller as related to the work to be performed by the subcontractors(s).

☐ Check this box if any subcontractor proposed under the Order, task order, or delivery order intends to subcontract more than seventy (70) percent of the total cost of work to be performed under the Order, task order, or delivery order, and provide the following information in the proposal:

1. The amount of the subcontractor's indirect cost and profit/fee applicable to the work to be performed by the lower-tier subcontractor(s); and
2. A description of the added value provided by the subcontractor as related to the work to be performed by the lower-tier subcontractors(s).
