

1. BASIC ORDERING AGREEMENT ("BOA") (Clause B-14.2) (February 2026)

GENERAL INFORMATION

This is a Basic Ordering Agreement ("BOA") for task orders or delivery orders, herein referred to generally as Orders ("Orders"). The purpose of this BOA is to provide a method for filling anticipated repetitive needs.

Supplies or services to be furnished under this BOA shall be ordered by issuance of Orders by the Buyer or Buyer's designee in this BOA. Buyer is only obligated to the extent authorized purchases are made under the BOA. Such Orders may be issued from BOA award date through BOA ordering period.

TERM AND ORDERING PERIOD

The term of this BOA is years from award of the BOA. [Buyer Note (please delete): Term should not exceed 10 years (including any options)] Order period of performance can exceed the term of this BOA if the Order was placed within the term.

MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM

BOA Order Minimum: There is no minimum ordering obligation under this BOA.

BOA Maximum: The total value of all Orders places against this BOA will not exceed \$ U.S. Dollars.

PRICING

Prices will be determined through one of the following approaches:

- a) Prices will be set for each Order based on competition among other BOA holders.
- b) Prices for future Orders may be negotiated for multiple years with either a firm-fixed-price ("FFP") or a fixed-price with economic price adjustment ("FP-EPA").

ORDER OF PRECEDENCE

The terms and conditions referenced in Section G of this BOA shall apply to all task and/or delivery orders.

Unless otherwise specified, for any inconsistency between the BOA, an Order, applicable terms and conditions, or the specifications and drawings, the inconsistency shall be resolved by giving precedence in the following order:

- a) Change Orders
- b) The Order document, including the applicable terms and conditions of purchase
- c) The BOA
- d) Specifications/Drawings
- e) Other documents

DPAS

Orders released against this BOA may be identified as DX, DO, and/or Unrated. If identified as DX or DO, these rated Orders are certified for national defense use and Seller is required to follow all provisions of the Defense Priorities and Allocations System regulations (15 CFR part 700).
