# 1. SHIPPING INSTRUCTIONS -- FM&T -- THIRD PARTY (Clause D-17.5) (October 2023)

## NOTICE

Failure to follow these routing instructions will result in a charge to your company for any excess freight costs.

"Prepay and Add" is not allowed.

Do not declare a value when shipping.

All shipments must be shipped COLLECT via the routing indicated below.

Weight per package should be limited to a maximum of 35 pounds where practicable due to ergonomic concerns associated with heavy packages.

### Shipment is to other than the Buyer's location (less than 150 pounds):

Ship via FedEx Ground "Collect" and check the block "Bill Recipient" on the bill of lading. Direct questions to FedEx at 800-762-3725.

OR

If FedEx Ground is unavailable or is not the customary carrier of the Seller, ship via United Parcel Service (UPS) surface "Collect" and check the block "Bill Recipient" on the bill of lading. Direct questions to UPS at 800-354-7527.

#### Shipment is to other than the Buyer's location (150 pounds to 5,000 pounds):

Ship via one of the following: FedEx Freight or UPS Freight

#### Shipment is to other than the Buyer's location (over 5,000 pounds):

Contact Buyer's Logistics Department for instructions (inboundequipment@kcnsc.doe.gov).

#### Process the Bill of Lading as follows:

Mark the body of the Bill of Lading to read: "Third Party Billing To Honeywell Federal Manufacturing & Technologies, LLC, 14520 Botts Road, Kansas City, MO 64147 shall be responsible for freight charges." Section 7 of the Bill of Lading (for non-FedEx Ground or non-UPS shipments) shall be left blank. Enter Buyer's purchase order/contract number on the Bill of Lading as a part of the description of articles shipped. Mail a copy of the Bill of Lading to the above address to the attention of Buyer's "Logistics Engineering Department".
