

## **1. UNCLASSIFIED CONTROLLED NUCLEAR INFORMATION UNDER TG-NNP-2 (Clause F-11.3) (February 2026)**

Buyer may provide Seller with documents and drawings marked Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information (UCNI) under this Order. By United States law, Seller is required to handle and control documents in accordance with requirements identified in 10 CFR 1017 *Identification and Protection of Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information* and DOE Order 471.1B *Identification and Protection of Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information*.

The Department of Energy approved variances to 10 CFR 1017 *Identification and Protection of Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information* and DOE Order 471.1B *Identification and Protection of Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information* for the identification and control of documents and materials determined to be UCNI. The following exemptions only apply to documents and materials identified as UCNI under TG-NNP-2.

Upon successful completion of Buyer's training course 36069 "UCNI Awareness Training for TG-NNP-2", and may mark, control and decontrol UCNI in accordance with 10 CFR 1017 and DOE Order 471.1B, Seller's subject matter experts (SMEs), information owners, originators, or possessors with cognizance over the information who are not UCNI Receiving Officials (ROs) are allowed to make UCNI determinations and identify as UCNI ROs on UCNI markings TG-NNP-2.

UCNI from TG-NNP-2 is protected in transmission as Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) which is consistent with current requirements for Export Controlled Information (ECI) and other Department of Energy (DOE) sensitive unclassified information. Seller shall comply with the transmission requirements outlined in Buyer's training course 36069 UCNI Awareness Training for TG-NNP-2. Additionally, Seller should mark and handle UCNI as ECI according to the product marking.
